## **Board Meeting Briefs:**

This section reports on items of general interest to the High Desert community that are discussed at the Board Meetings. It does not cover all items discussed at the meeting, nor in any way represent minutes from the meeting.

Elena Gallegos Open Space Improvement: Open Space personnel described their feasibility investigation for an Education Center in the Elena Gallegos Open Space. The evaluation is still in progress, and their website describes the effort.

Amazon Gate Access Box: The Board voted to allow Amazon to install gate access boxes that will grant access to Amazon drivers when delivering packages to gated villages. The gate will only open if the delivery code scanned by the driver authenticates to an address in that village. Besides simplifying entry for authorized personnel, Amazon will provide simpler claim handling if any packages are stolen in villages using these access boxes.

Future Board Meetings: The Board voted to reduce their meeting frequency so that they will now meet every other month instead of monthly.

Townhall Meeting: More than 80 homeowners registered for the January Townhall Meeting. Our Board President, Reg Rider, provided open discussion about recent Board activities, and homeowners shared their questions, ideas, and opinions. The next Townhall Meeting will be in March, and we'll remind you about it in the March High Desert Bulletin.

Pet Stations: At the January Townhall Meeting, some homeowners expressed frustration with the amount of dog waste around the Altezza apartments. Due to vacation time by Yellowstone Landscaping, the pet stations did not get emptied on schedule. This has been addressed and High Desert is investigating whether additional pet stations can be placed on the bordering streets, Cortaderia and Imperata, to encourage dog owners to clean up after their pets.

High Desert Security Vehicles: The High Desert security patrols will normally be conducted in vehicles labeled High Desert Security, but please be aware that sometimes the patrols will be conducted in vehicles labeled G4S or Allied Universal. Allied Universal Security is the company that bought out G4S last year.
