HOAMCO High Desert Office Security – Due to recent criminal activity in the area, the HOAMCO office will remain locked. Please call the office number 505-314-5862 if you are in the parking lot, and HOAMCO staff will let you into the building. A new security door is being ordered, which will use a call button to allow access into the building.

Community Wildfire Protection Plan – Those who attended the October Townhall heard about Bernalillo County's Community Wildfire Protection Plan. Their <u>brochure</u> has specific steps that you as a homeowner can take to be prepared, and it is now available on our High Desert website in the <u>Fire Safety</u> section. Our Fire Preparedness Committee has also learned that there might be grant money available for High Desert to make such preparations.

Efficient Irrigation Presentation - On November 16 from 12:30 to 2:30 Smart Use will present to the Board a talk on helping to make the High Desert irrigation system as efficient as possible while achieving the landscape goals of promoting native and low water use plants and maintaining the health of those plants. The goal is to reduce water costs and minimize or eliminate irrigation surcharges. Dead Trees being Removed – Did you notice? Yellowstone has already begun the removal of dead trees in High Desert common areas. Plans to replace the trees will be developed later.

The recordings are intended for short term use for preparing minutes and for viewing by people who were unable to attend the meetings.
