Estate Sale Policy – The High Desert Board approved a new Estate Sale Policy at the March Board meeting. Estate Sales will be allowed for two consecutive days with prior approval. Read the full policy on our website. Please remember that garage sales, rummage sales, and similar events are still not allowed in High Desert, as stated in our covenants.

Small Increase in Assessments – The Board announced that there will be a small increase in Base Assessments of \$3 per month, starting in July. Desert Mountain residents will have an additional \$3 per month increase for their Gated Village Assessment. The other gated villages will have no increase in their Gated Village Assessment at this time.

Defensible Space Actions for May from Fire Preparedness Committee:

The New Mexico State University and Firewise suggest you take these steps to reduce home risk during this wildfire season:

- Thin shrubs to reduce fuel and separate them from other plants.
- Prune trees and trim up from the ground. Remove branches over or within ten feet of the house and roof.
- Clear roof and canales of debris.
- Check the integrity of the chimney, fireplace, and air vents. Use less than one-quarter-inch screen mesh to block embers.
