A motion was made by Ray Berg and seconded by George Marsh to approve the proposal. The Board discussed the recommendation, and the motion was carried unanimously.

Enclave/Imperata Wall Repairs: A motion was made by Ray Berg and seconded by George Marsh to ratify the vote to split the cost of the wall repairs between the Enclave and the master association. The motion was discussed, and it was carried unanimously.

An acceptance letter of completion will be provided and signed by the residents of The Enclave once the work is complete.

Nominating Committee Chairperson/Committee Member Appointments: A motion was made by Bob Howell and seconded by Ray Berg to ratify the vote to approve Tammi Dorsey as the committee chair and to appoint Harrison Jones, Susan Camp and Mark Soo Hoo to the committee. The motion was carried unanimously.

Amazon Key: The Board discussed this request. The request was deferred pending a review by the contracts and the gated village committees.

Good afternoon, everyone.

I am reaching out about getting the Board's approval for a project in Enclave in between our monthly meetings. I'm reaching out in this manner because if we wait until the November board meeting, we may not have good weather to move on this project.

Back at the board meeting in July, the Board approved a project for Enclave to paint the portion of the wall that had been raised by High Desert in 2022. The interior side of the wall along Imperata was left unfinished and was rather unsightly to homeowners. That work was completed in mid-August.

After that work was done, there were several owners who complained about the paint not matching the remainder of their walls and so Enclave Voting Members had agreed to paint the wall at their cost, allowing these 7 owners to pick the color of their choice. In the meantime, I also started receiving complaints about the sloppy work that was done on the wall when it was raised, where mortar was missing or was left bulging between blocks and where excess mortar was left on the ground in owner's back yards. I have been able to get the excess mortar cleaned from all residents' walls where it was bulging between blocks or on the ground. However, for the work that was done on the walls, this left an uneven appearance, and I still needed to be able to address the missing mortar. I've had two general contractors looks at the walls and they both have said the best solution is to take down the new rows of block and do the work again. This would be extremely cost prohibitive to the Association though. We've looked at alternatives, like caulking or re-mortaring the joints between the blocks, but neither general contractor will guarantee or warranty the work. One contractor has recommended that we put a scratch coat over the entirety of those affected walls for a uniform appearance, and then the walls can be painted. Repairs need to be performed on 4 of the 7 walls.

After meeting with the Enclave Voting Members and George and Bill last Friday, there has been a tentative agreement to allow the scratch coat and painting, and to again split the costs between High Desert and Enclave. I've bid the painting work with three contractors, and Bob's Painting is the least costly to repaint 7 walls for \$3,616.20. MountainSide Contractors bid the scratch coat work for \$8,990.00 (\$9675.49 with tax). The total cost for this project would be \$13291.69. Split between the two parties, this would be \$6645.85/ \$6645.84. Due to the overall cost, George and Bill asked me to bring this to the entire board for a decision.

In order to move on business in between a meeting, I would need unanimous consent in writing from all Board members. If the Board is not able to reach unanimous approval over email, would it be possible to call a short board meeting to discuss the business and have the Board vote on the matter? In this method, only a simple majority vote is required.

Everyone, please let me know your thoughts about the project, what questions you might have and if you would approve of the project as outlined above. George and Bill, if you have any additional

information you want to share about our discussion with Enclave on Friday, please add your comments as well.


